REPORT ON THE WORK.

We would like to inform you about our work. We want to thank the people and organizations who support us and fight against doping in billiards sports. Special thanks to Genevieve Kerckret from France for her work in Medical Committee of WCBS.

From 2012 to 2017 – WCBS Anti-Doping Committee (ADC) has been working to develop programs SAY NO! TO DOPING and PLAY TRUE. WCBS has made special T-shirts, banners and stickers. For the first time in the history of the billiards sports over 60 organizations placed the logo of those programs on their websites. We received thanks for WADA Developing Department.

In 2015 – Mr. Krzeminski – vice president , chairman of WCBS Anti-Doping Committee wrote the new WCBS Anti-Doping Code. It is a kind of “anti-doping Bible” for billiard. 95 pages document. <http://www.wcbs-billiards.org/integrity/>. WADA informed us on 7 January 2015 that:

We confirm that WCBS has successfully incorporated all mandatory articles of the 2015 World Anti-Doping Code into its Rules. This correspondence therefore constitutes your assurance that the 2015 WCBS Draft Rules are in line with the 2015 World Anti-Doping Code.

2016- WCBS nominated 20 players to the “International level group” and offered them anti-doping service by WCBS Anti-Doping Committee. We haven’t received 4 names of the players from professional snooker.

2017 – WADA sent us Compliance Questionnaire User – 179 questions of our anti-doping activities. Mr. Krzeminski did this job.

Since 2012 Mr. Krzeminski has been the administrator of ADAMS system (WADA - electronic anti-doping system) – only man in our sports who has a passport to manage this program. He controls and offers service for players in Registered Testing Pool.

2016-2017 WCBS ADC conducted anti-doping investigations for 5 players. We suspended 2 of them.

WCBS ADC promoted logo of anti-doping programs during pool, carom and pyramid tournaments in which participated:

820 players in 2013

880 players in 2014

1.090 players in 2015

1.212 players in 2016

about 1.543 players in 2017.

WCBS ADC together with Polish ADO organized in 2017 anti-doping course for pool instructors and referees.

We try to control all anti-doping tests organized by WADA laboratories. Billiard sport has to conduct 28 tests a year.

WCBS ADC sends about 100 anti-doping responses to WADA, billiard organizations and players each year.

Chairman of the WCBS ADC had meetings regarding anti-doping issues with presidents or managements of UMB, EMB, EBSF, WPA, IBSF, EPBF, APBU, CPB and presidents of national organizations from Germany, Poland, Slovakia, Hungary, Norway, Finland, Croatia, Russia, Ukraine, Belarus, Lithuania, South Africa, Egypt, Moldova, Austria, Libya, Morocco and Bulgaria.

Mr. Krzeminski – vice president of WCBS participated in main world sport congresses: Sport Accord Conventions in Quebec (2012), Lausanne (2016) and Aarhus (2017) when he presented cue sports for IOC, ARISF, IWGA, WADA and SportAccord Organization. He had meetings with: IOC sport directors, IOC director responsible for contact with international federations, director of Olympic Media Chanel, management of WADA, Sport Accord Doping Free Sport Unit and International World Games Association.

On behalf of WCBS Mr. Krzeminski was the assistant of competition manager of World Games – Cali 2013 and person responsible for billiard event of World Games - Wroclaw 2017. He was a representative of WCBS for the SportAccord International Forum in Lausanne 2017.

Success of our further anti-doping activities depends on good cooperation. We encourage to contact with NADO (National Anti-Doping Organizations) and ADC of WCBS.
